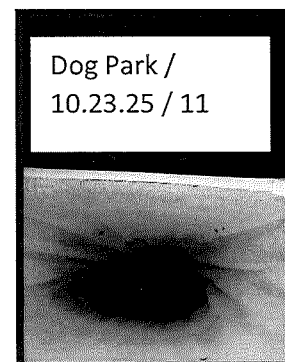
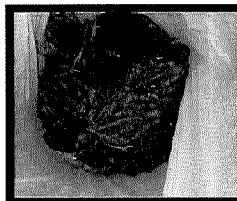
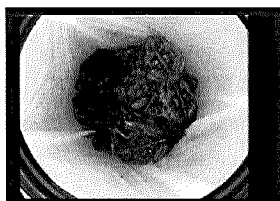
Summary of Visit – A thorough inspection of the HOA's common grounds (streets and amenity areas throughout Palmira) took place for the removal of the invasive Cane toads. **There was an estimated count of 250 Cane toads removed throughout this month. There was 11 Cane toads removed from the Palmira Dog Park on the night of October 23rd.** The areas reported from Management and/or Owners have been checked well and we will keep on our radar for future visits. We highly recommend that Owners keep lights off at night, or switch to bug lightbulbs. This will help keep the Cane toads from hanging out close to homes, under lights.

****Some Owners are reporting to us the treefrogs that sit at the front door, front walkway or on garage lights. These are treefrogs and not Cane toads. If anyone is not certain on what they are seeing, send us a picture and we can help to identify the species. Treefrogs will be found on side of walls, Cane toads are found on the ground.**

****Native Southern Toads are present in this community as well; not all are Cane Toads. We remove the Cane toads only and will leave native species and tree frogs. Invoice attached. Picture below shows some of the catch for this month.**
